# Project Narratives

- JAMES KENNEY BALL FIELD** Renovate ball field, including turf, sprinkler system, dug-outs, infield, bleachers.
- JAMES KENNEY TOTLOT** Provide play equipment for two Tot areas created by new Recreation Center.
- 10TH & ADDISON** Purchase 3 vacant lots, design and build Mini-Park.
- FRANKLIN PARENT NURSERY** Using perhaps the Western half of the site develop a School-Park for neighborhood and school use.
- AQUATIC PARK** Using a State matching Grant, develop the remaining East shore to increase its recreational potential, and to make the Park more accessible to the West Berkely neighborhood.
- AQUATIC PARK SKI AREA** Improvements at Ski area to reduce needed maintenance.
- AQUATIC PARK ROADWAY** Improvements to road and pathways.
- CEDAR & ROSE PARK & RECREATION CENTER** Purchase large parcels, including a church building suitable for use as a Recreation Center. Develop as a District Park.
- KING POOL AREA** Construct play and picnic area adjacent to King Swim Center.
- BART PARK & RECREATION CENTER** Acquire the open "BART Strip" along Hearst Ave., and develop as Park, with open space, Recreation and Senior Center, Crafts Center, etc.
- THOUSAND OAKS SCHOOL** Develop the entire School Yard as a School-Park. No other open space exists for neighborhood.
- GRIZZLY PEAK SCHOOL** Make materials available for volunteers to construct play area on school grounds.
- JOHN HINKEL PARK** Picnic, path and play area constuction and renovation.
- VIRGINIA & LE ROY** Purchase of 1 lot, construction of Mini-Park with tot emphasis.
- CIVIC CENTER ELECTRICAL** Needed repairs to Civic Center electrical system.
- CIVIC CENTER TOTLOT** New equipment and renovation of existing equipment.
- JOHN MUIR SCHOOL** Development of School-Park on portion of school yard, with emphasis on use of with emphasis on use of grove.
- WEAL** Closure of street, use of portion as Mini-Park.
- BATEMAN** Development of Mini-Park on land provided by Alta Bates Hospital.
- LE CONTE SCHOOL** Development of School-Park on portion of school yard.
- WALKER SCHOOL** Closure of street, use of portion as Mini-Park.
- HALCYON COURT** Use of portion of a wide street for development of Mini-Park.
- GROVE PARK & RECREATION CENTER** Purchase of additional properties, acquisition of adjacent school properties and use of Grant St. to redevelop Grove into a major recreational Center.
- MALCOLM X SCHOOL** Development of School-Park on portion of school yard.
- FAIRVIEW AT ADELINE** Development of large parcel adjacent to Greg Brown Park.
- HARMON AT GREG BROWN PARK** Purchase and development of parcel adjacent to Greg Brown Park.
- OPPORTUNITY FUND** For purchase of key parcels that may become suddenly available. Purchase must be approved by Recreation and Planning Commissions.
- PARK DIVISION STAFF** This funds any support clerical, research, design and presentation work, other than specific projects required by the Recreation and Planning Commissions.
- SUPERVISION** Provides supervision for CETA crew. Crew's salaries paid by Federal Grant, and will total approximately \$100,000 for one year period.
- MATERIALS** Provides CETA crew with materials. Crew will be doing park renovation projects, with emphasis on reduction of maintenance.
